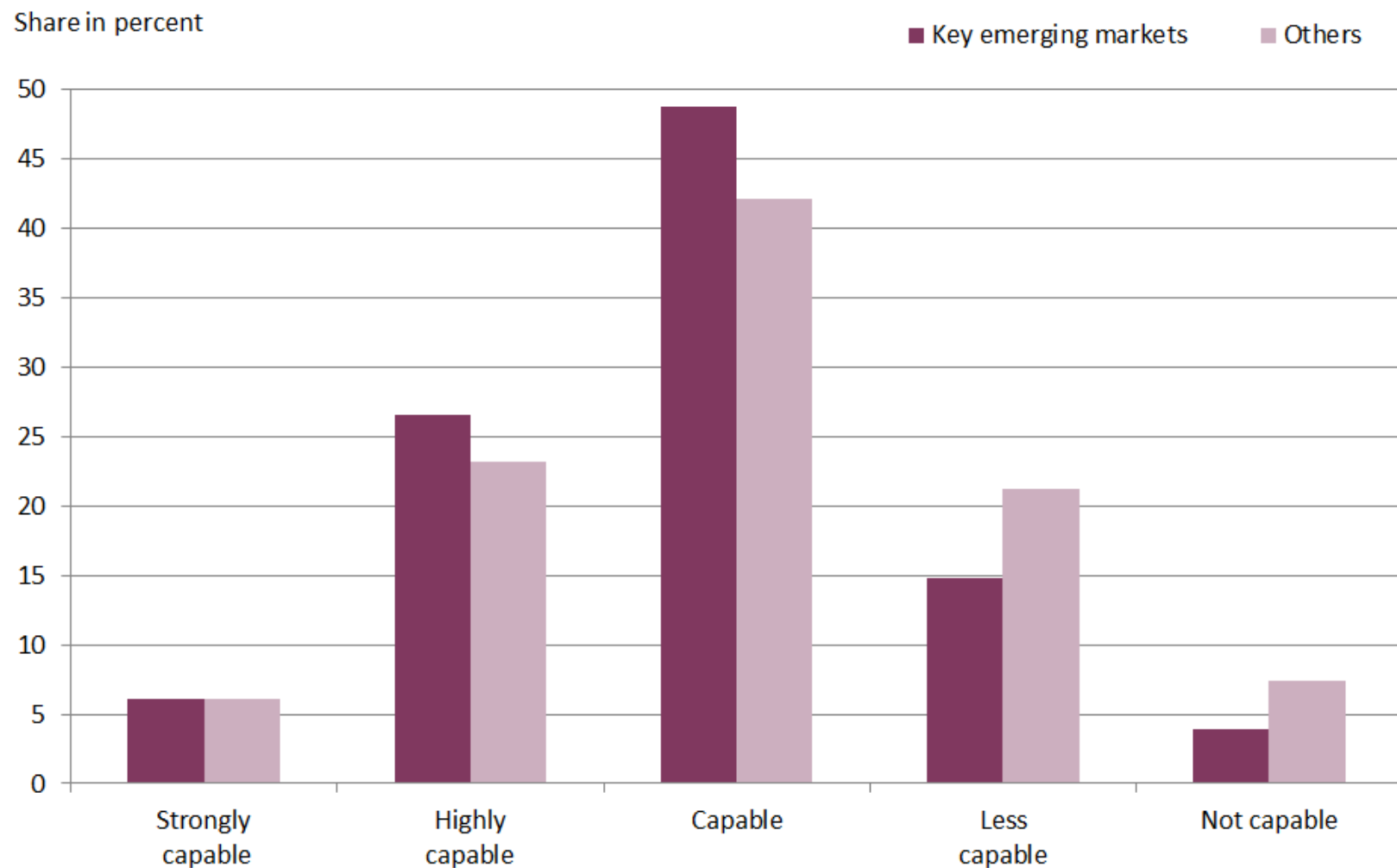

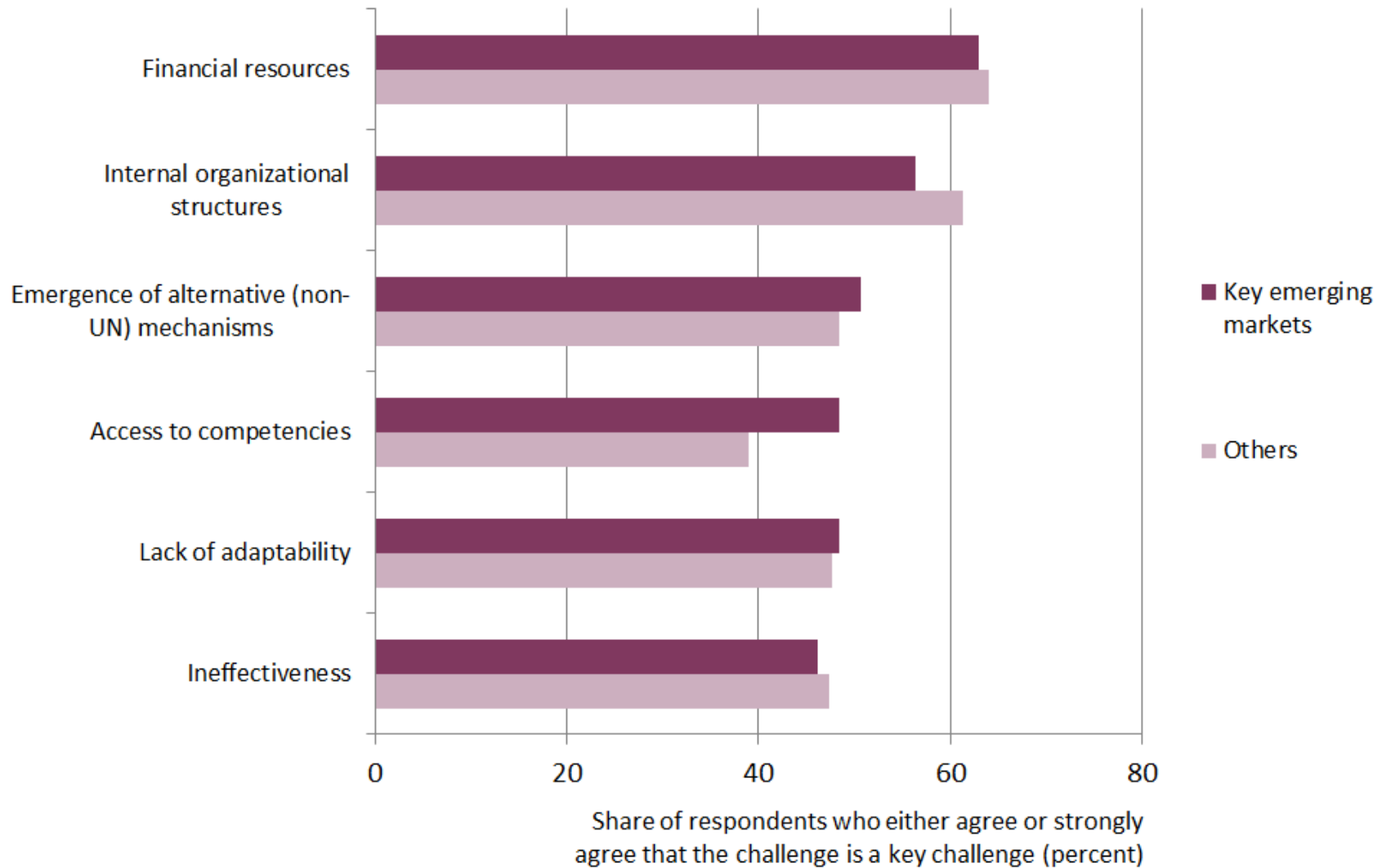

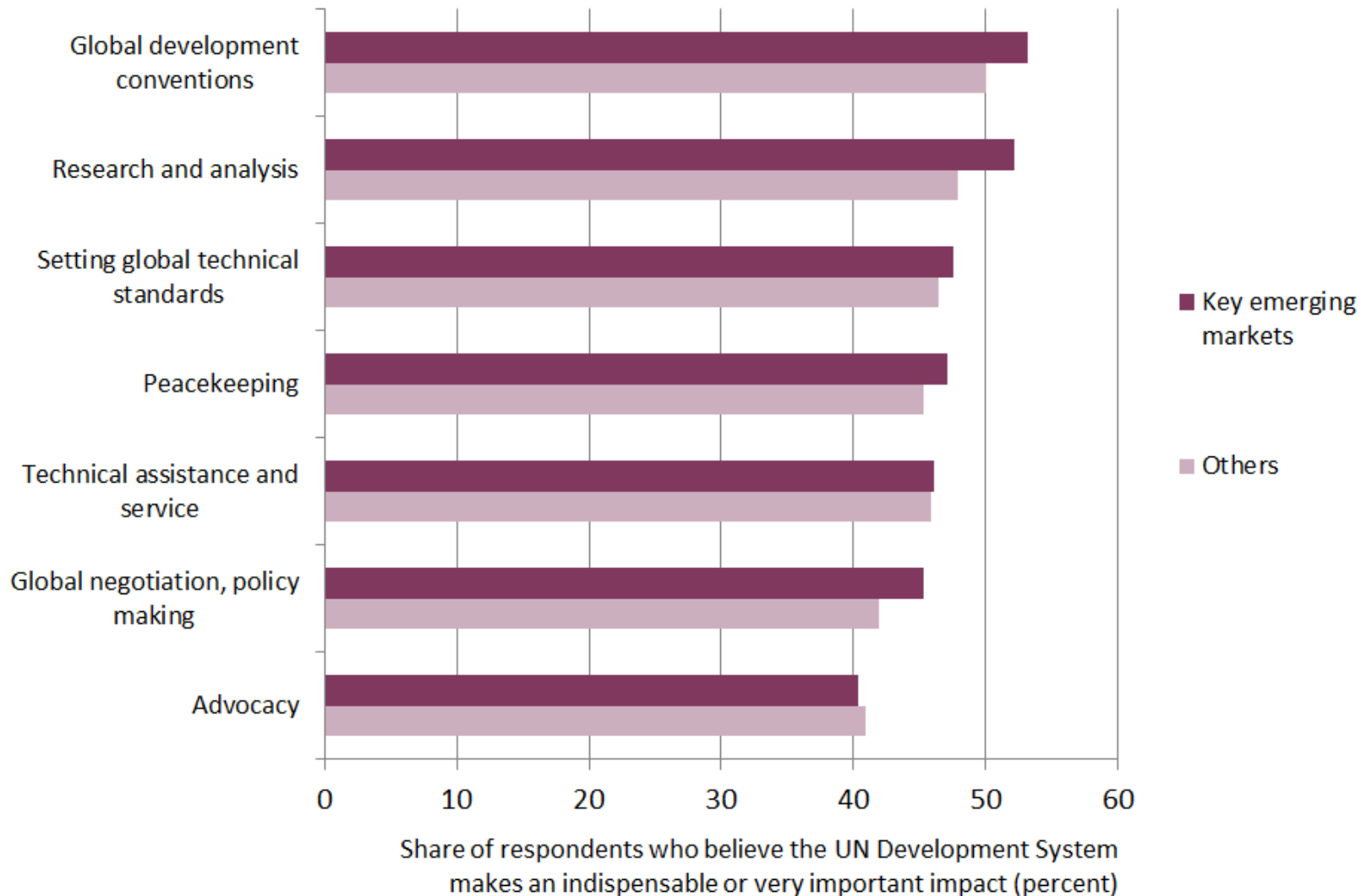

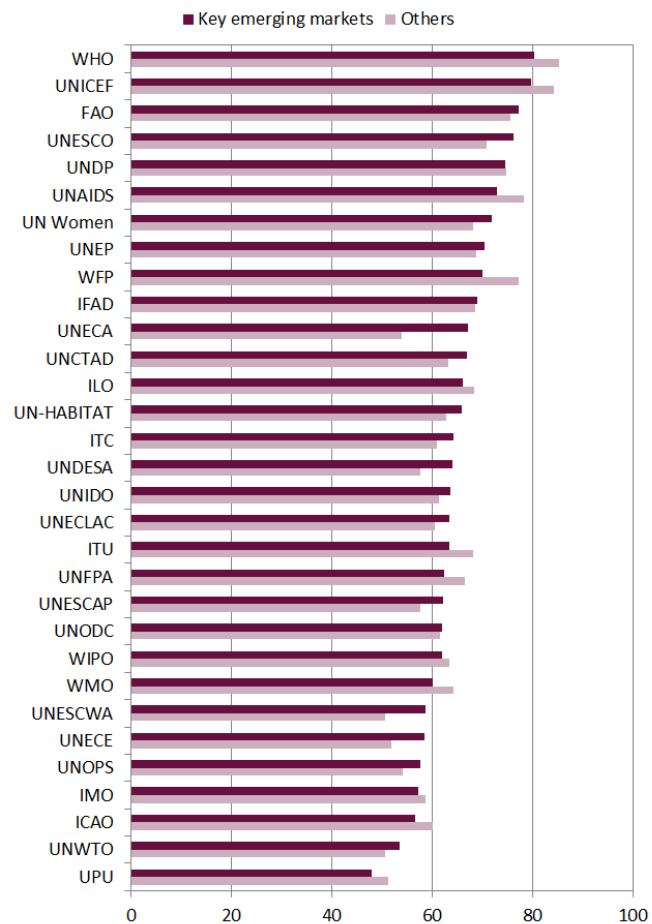

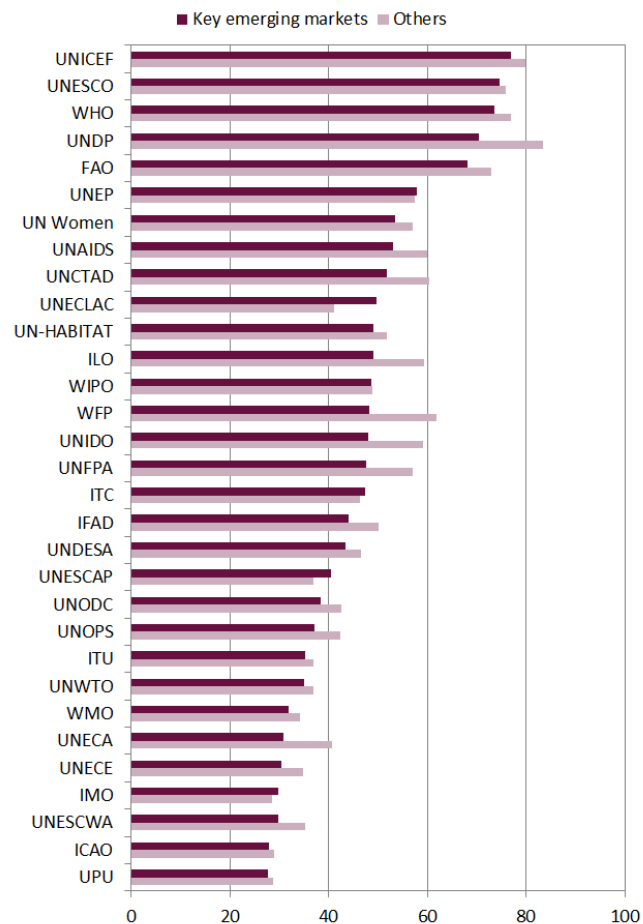
*Share of respondents who perceive the organization as relevant (%)*

*Share of respondents familiar with the organization (%)*

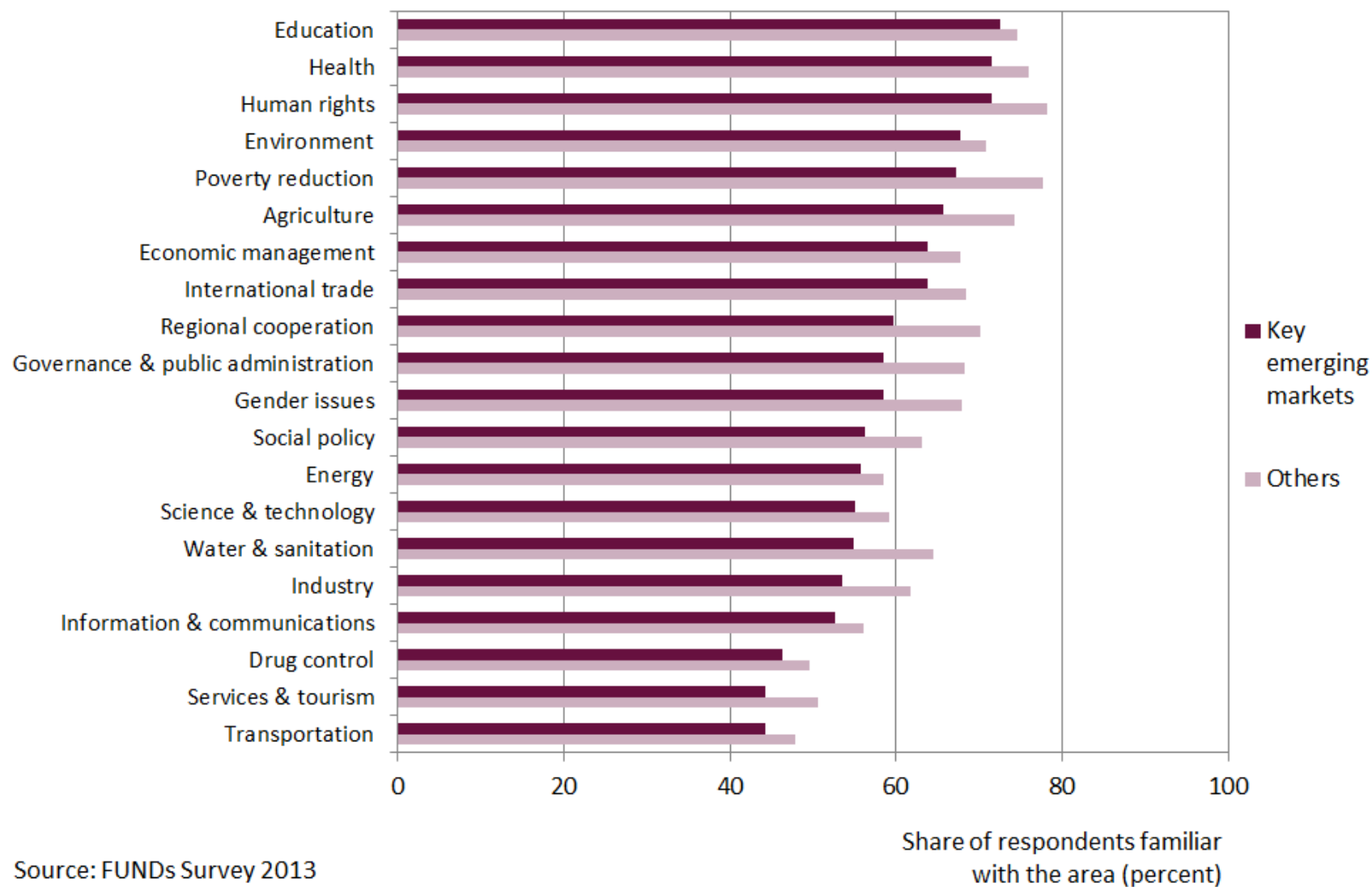

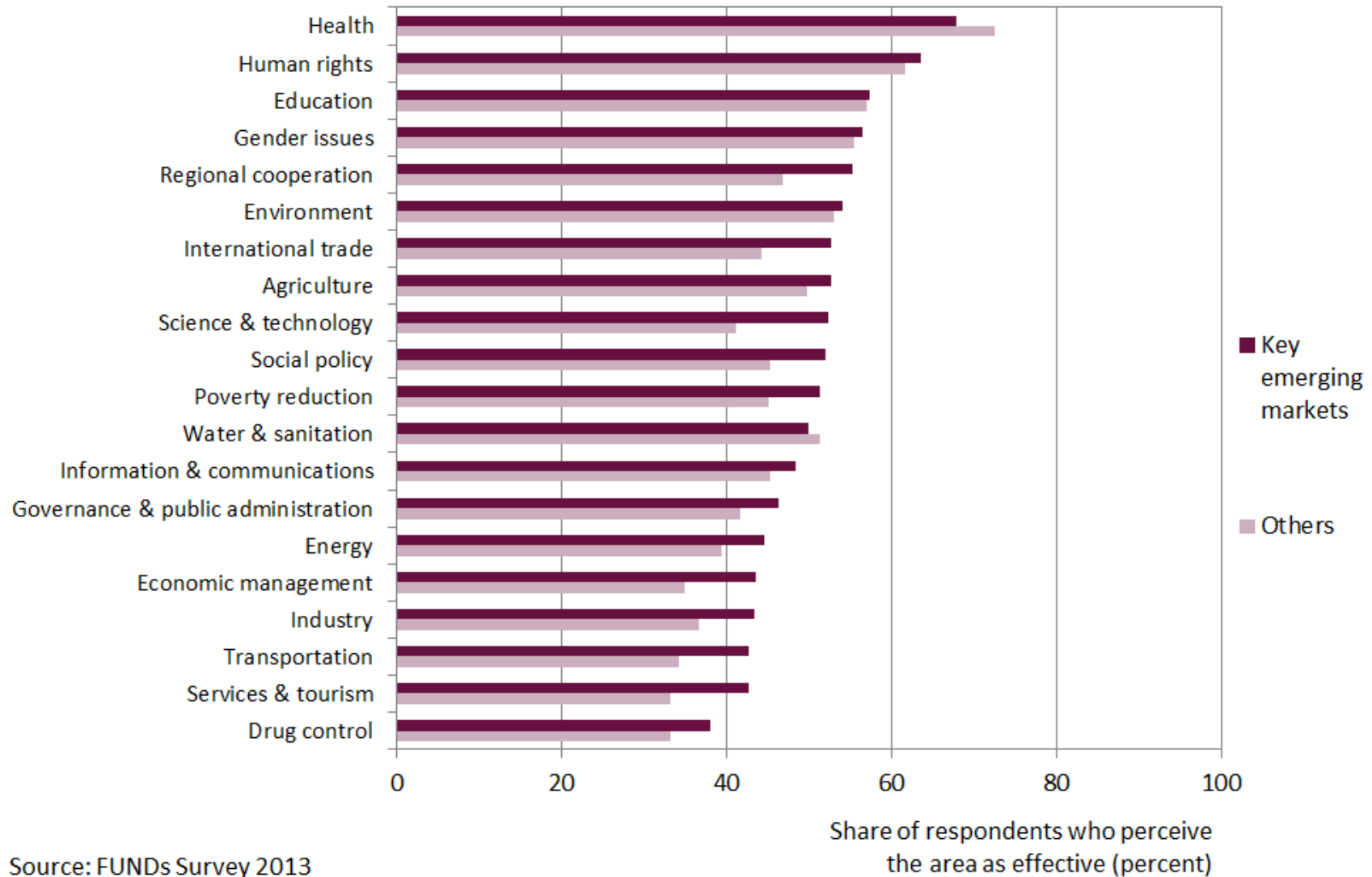

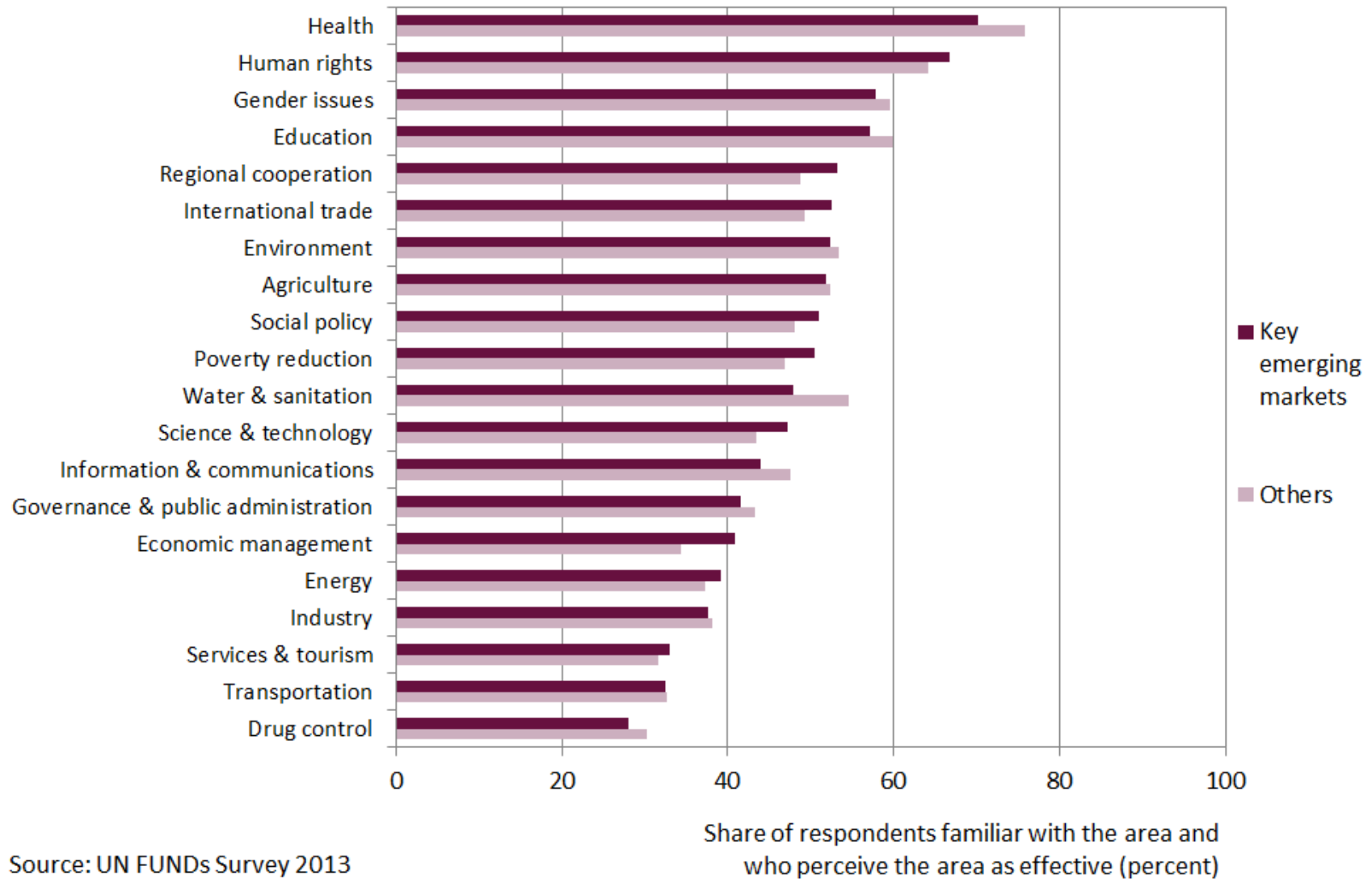

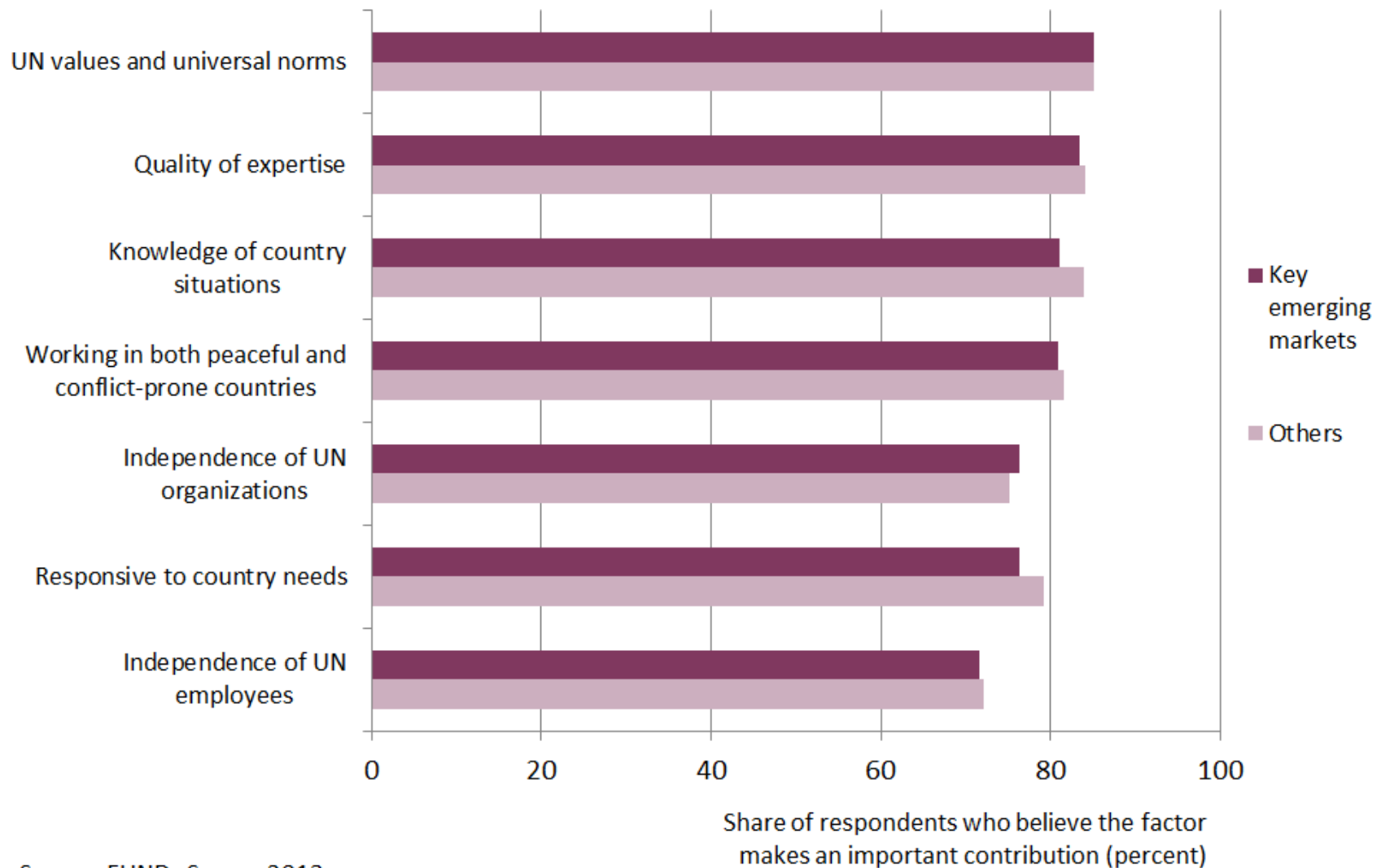
# UN Development System effectiveness: Perception of effectiveness



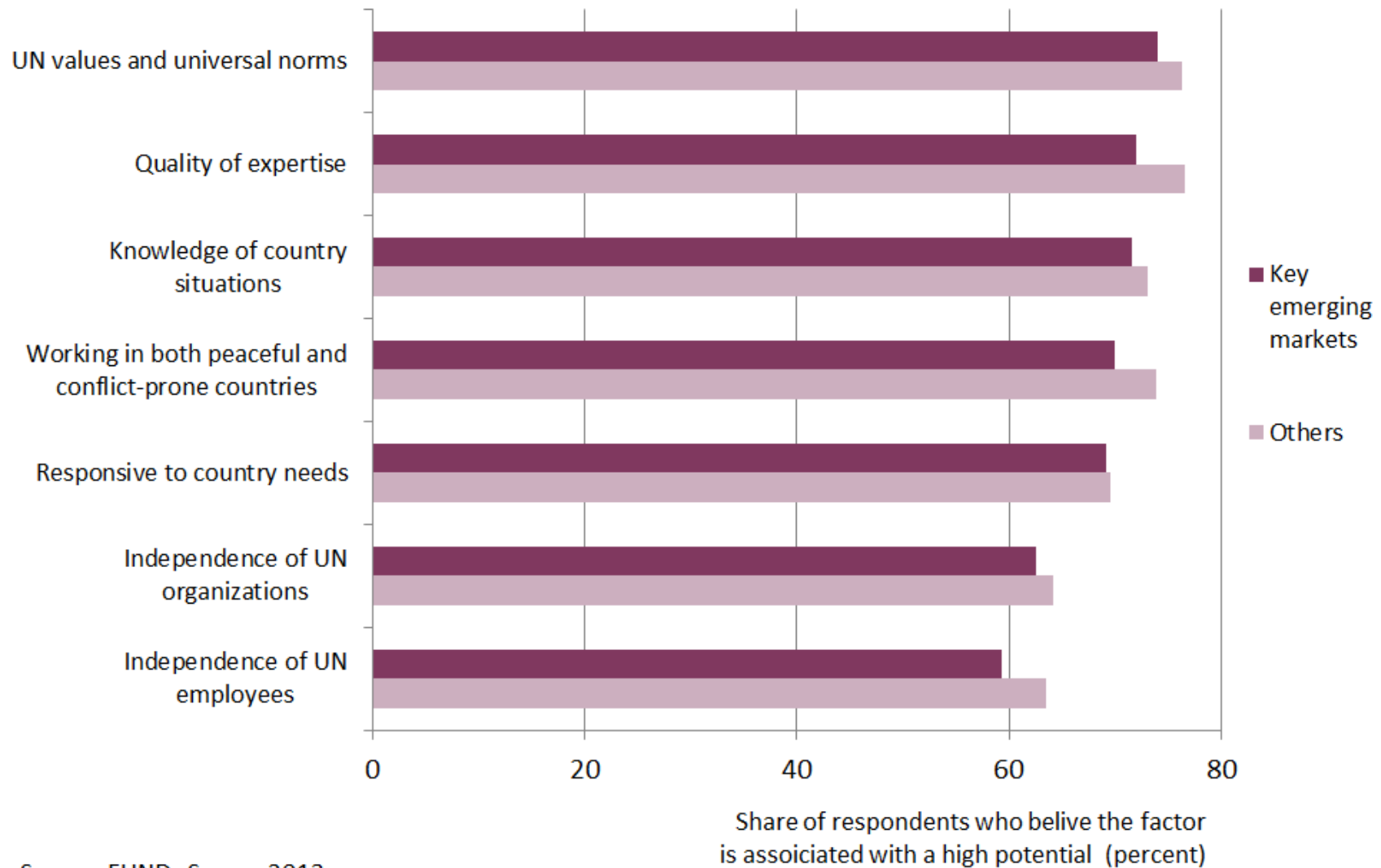

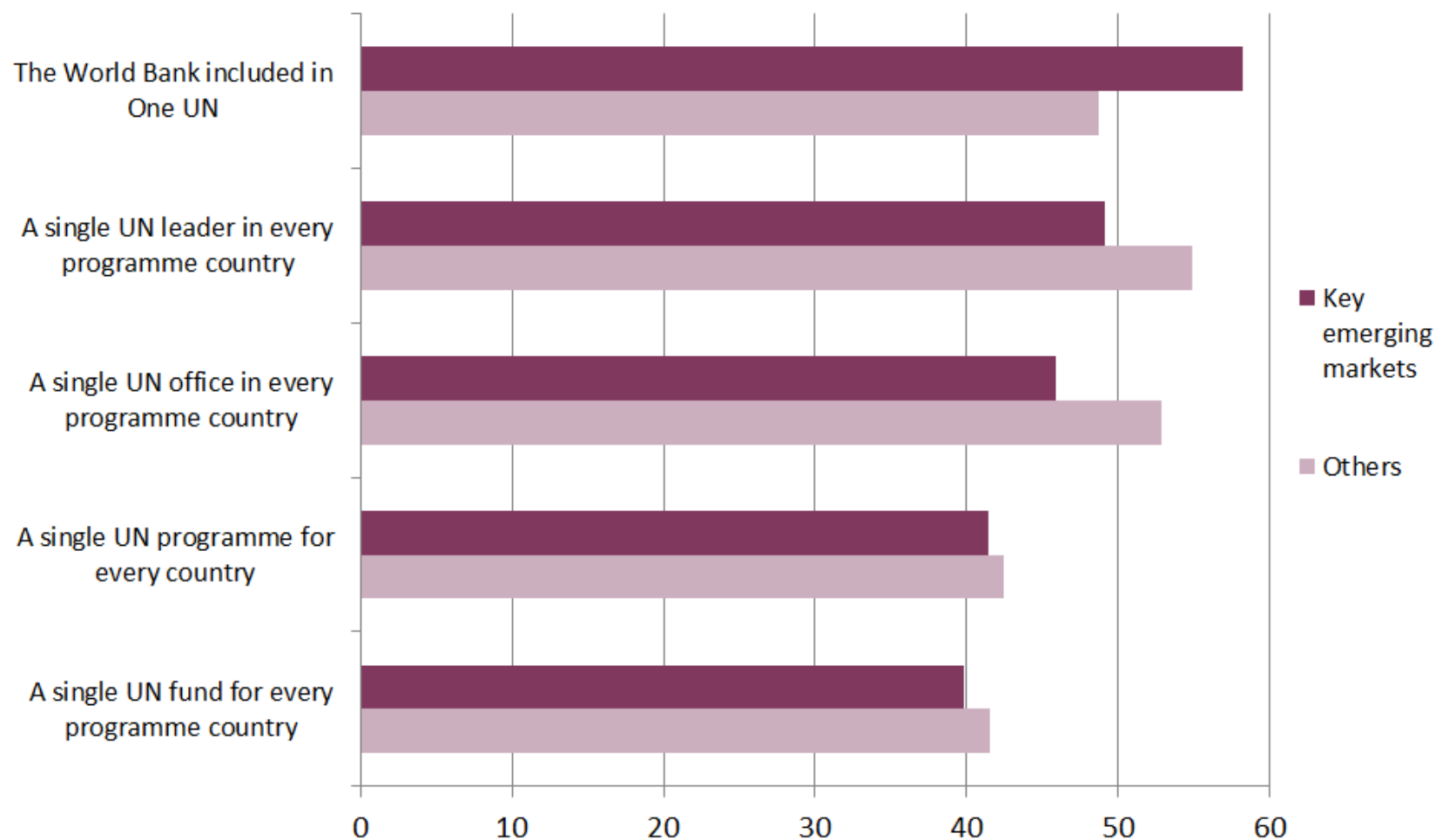

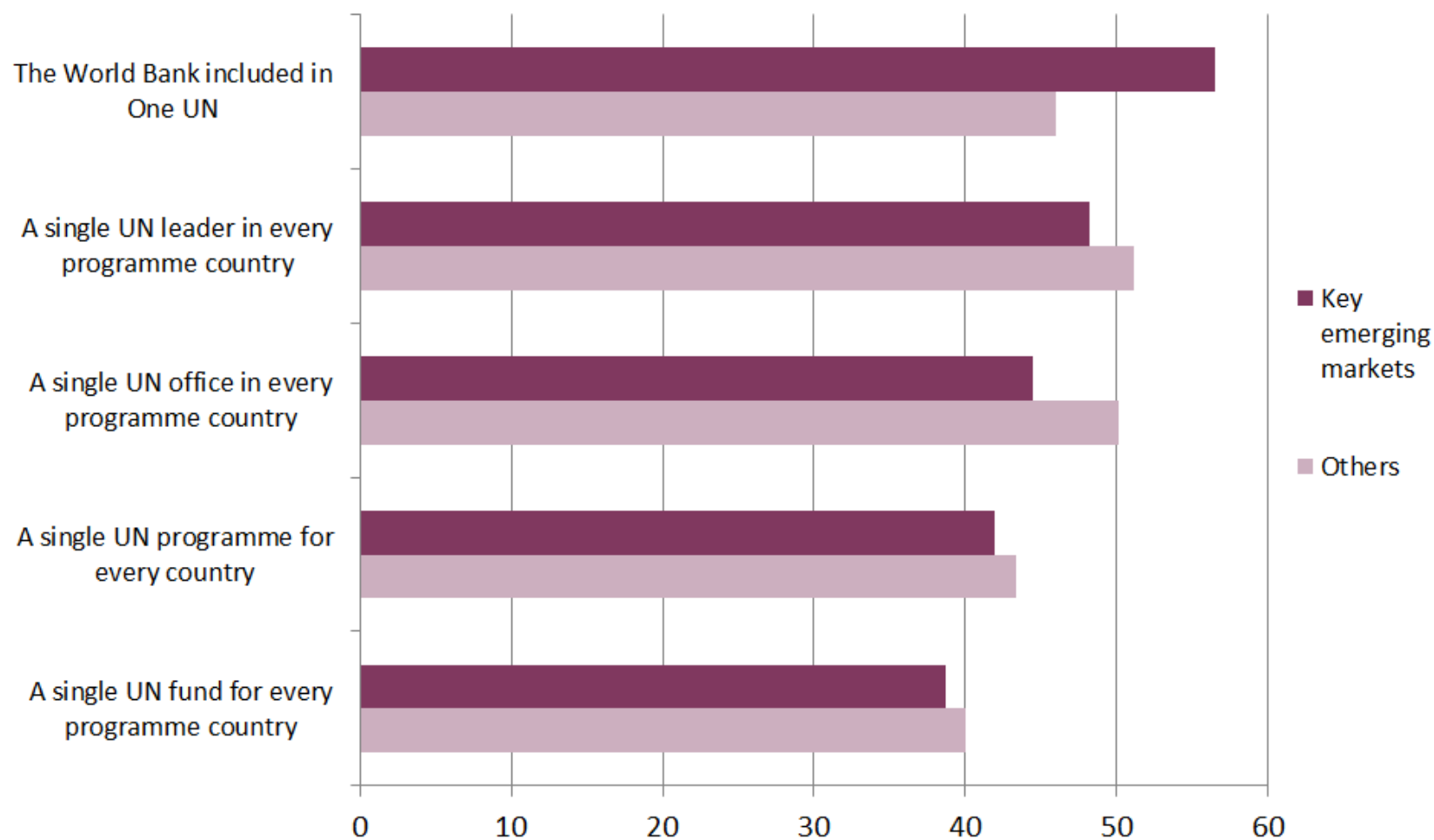

Share of respondents who believe that delivering as one enhances the UN development system in terms of efficiency (percent)

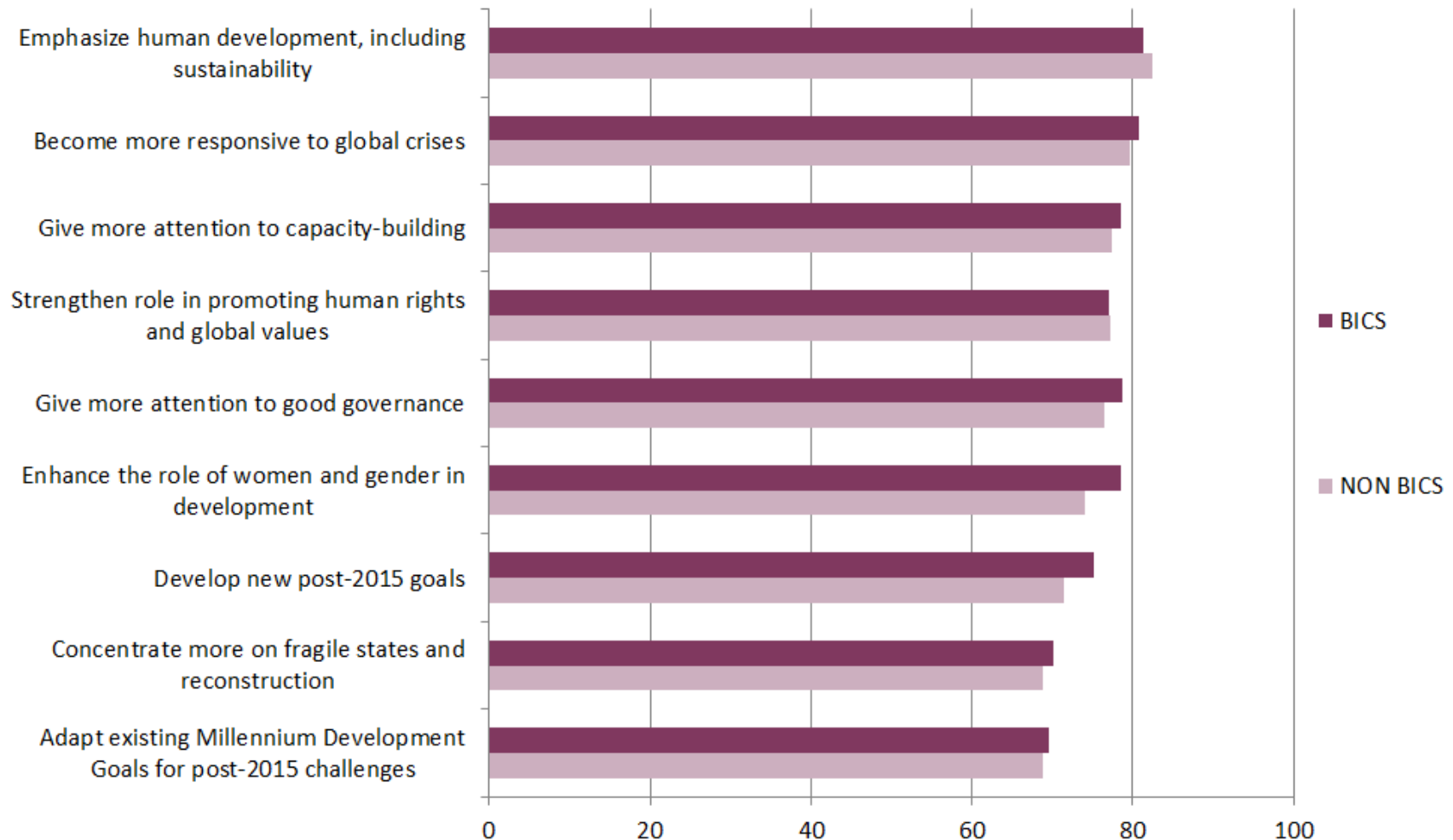

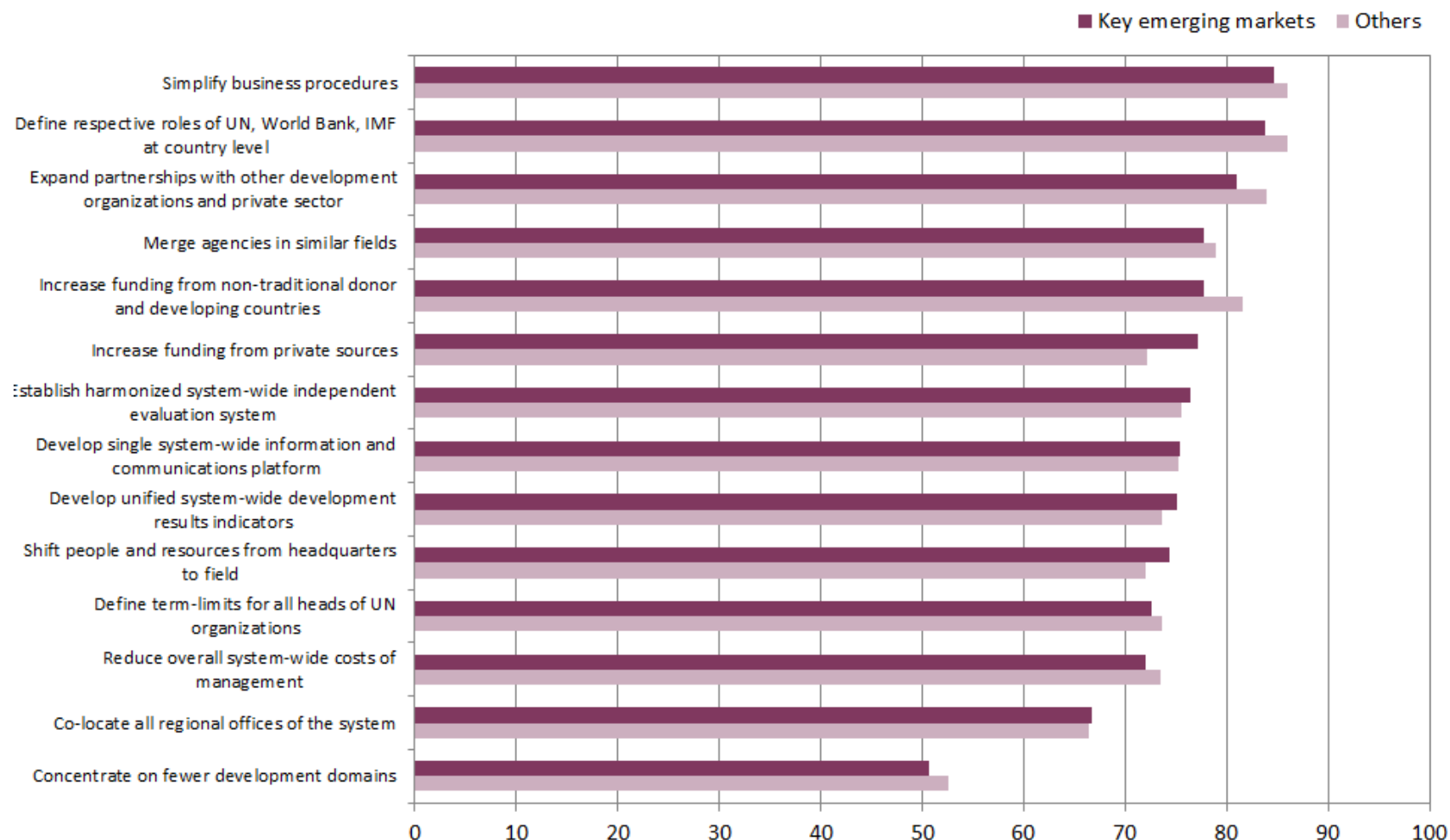

Share of respondents who agree or strongly agree that the agenda should be given high priority going forward (percent)



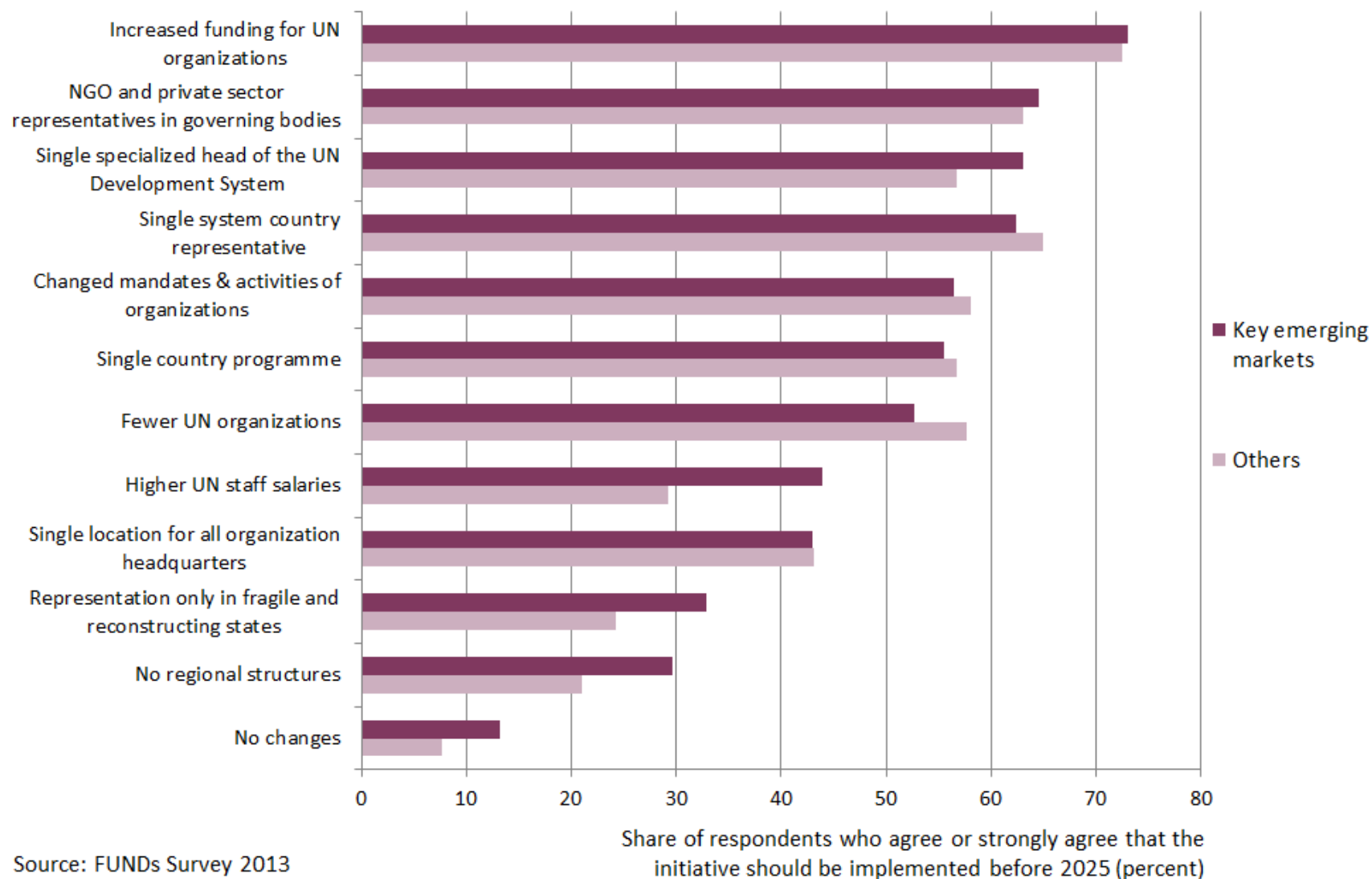

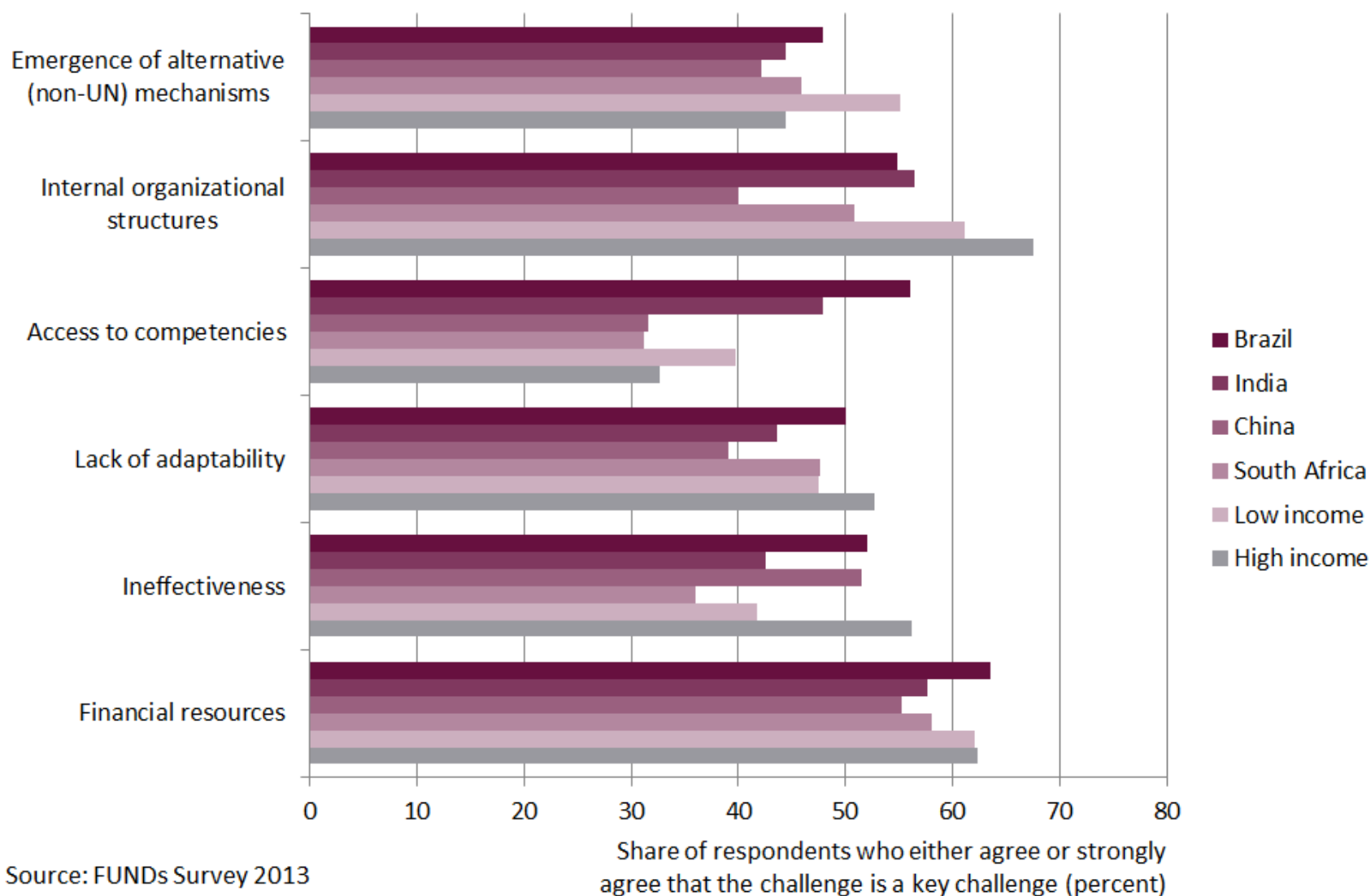

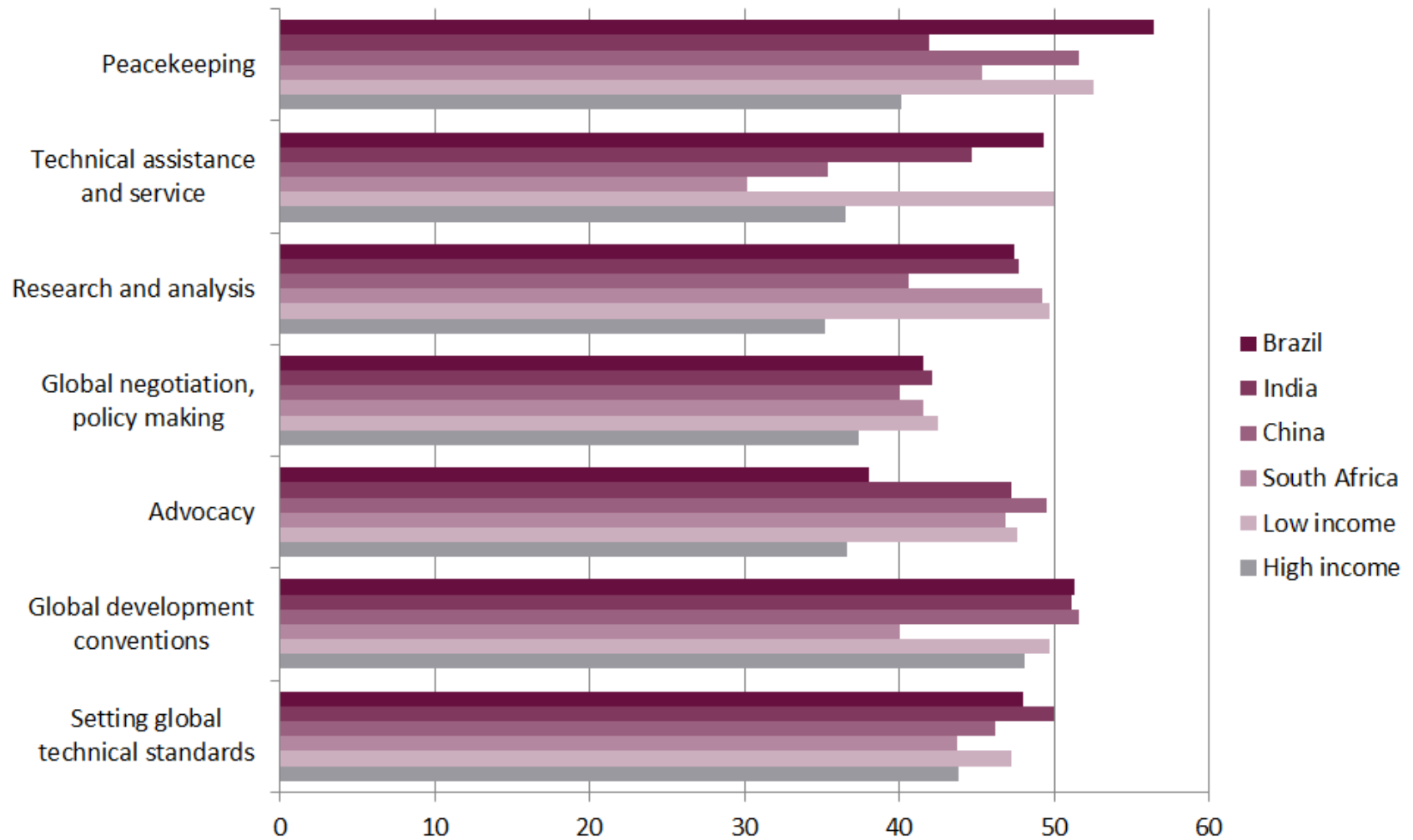

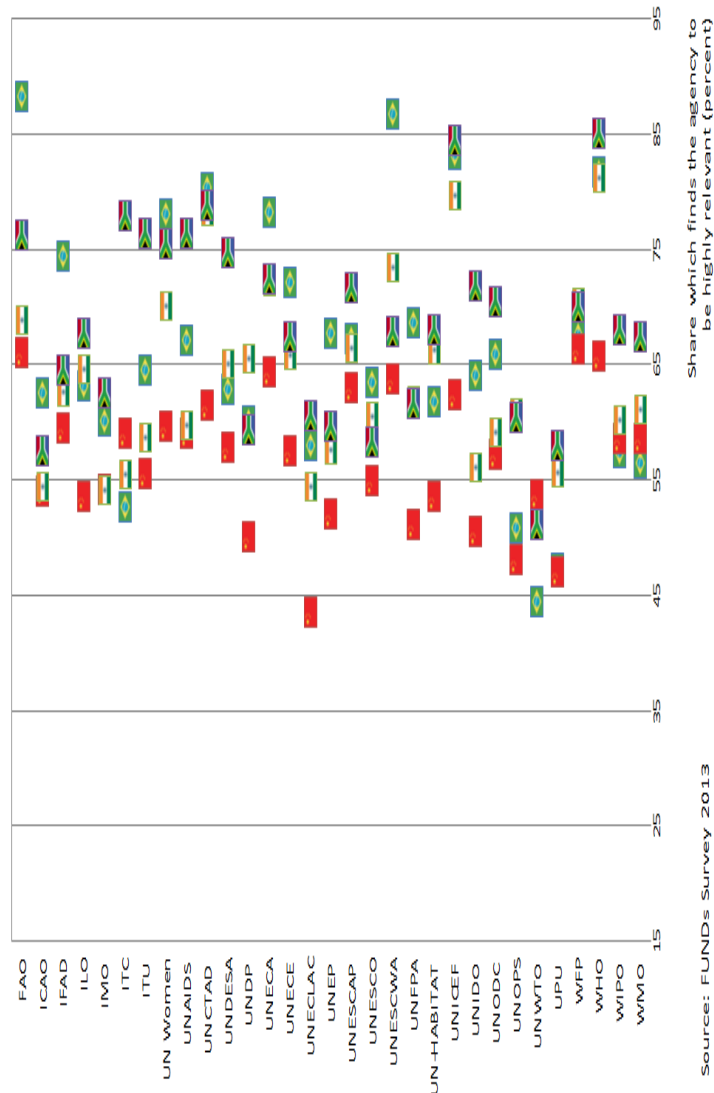

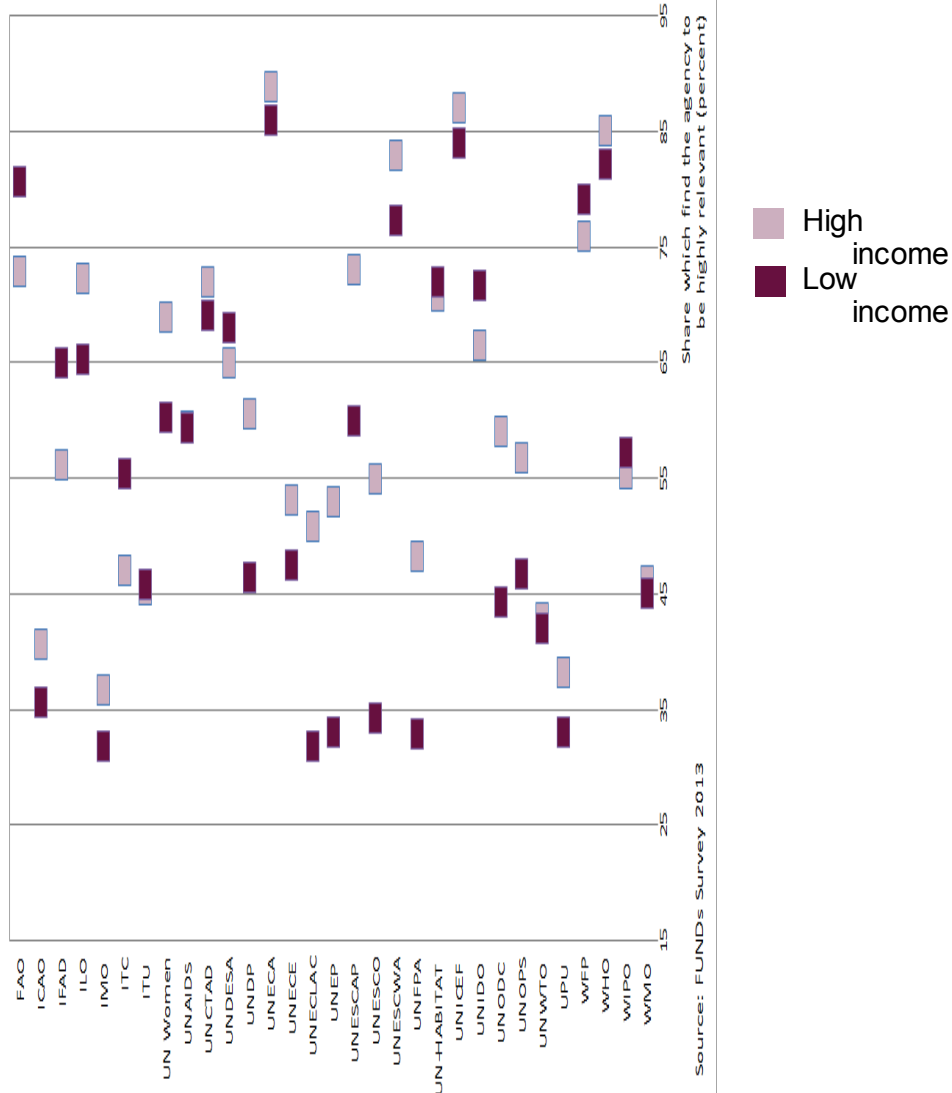

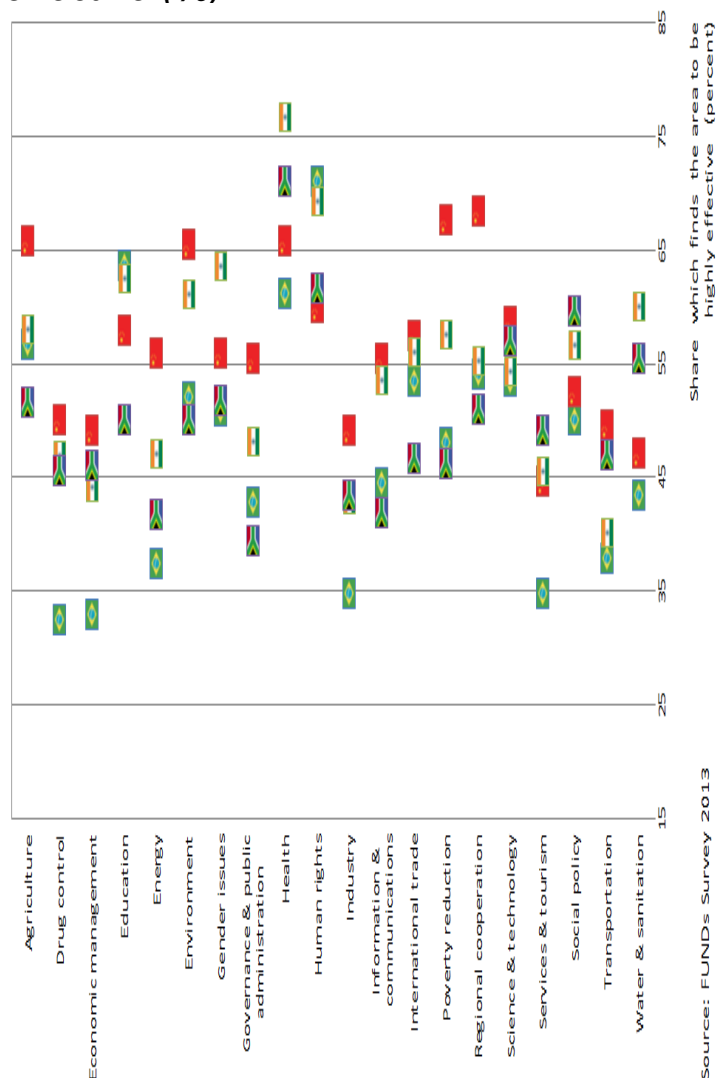

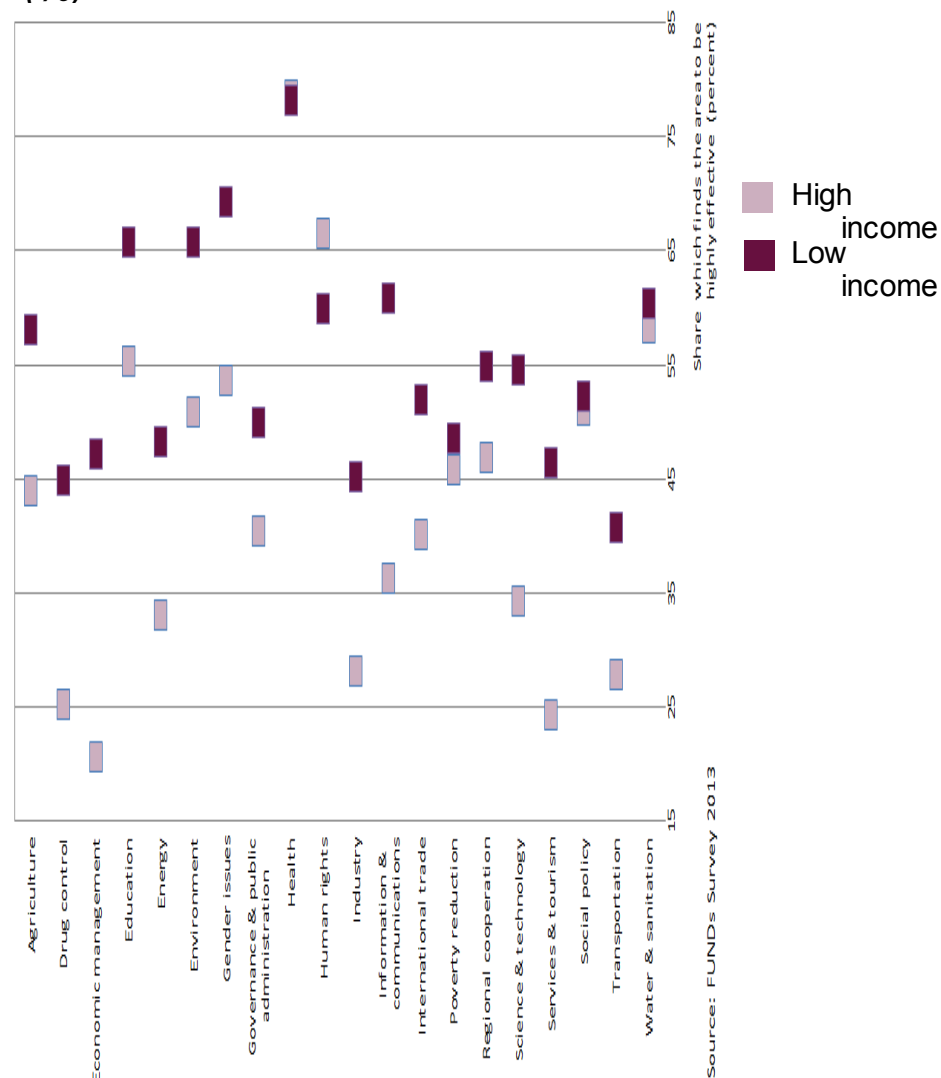

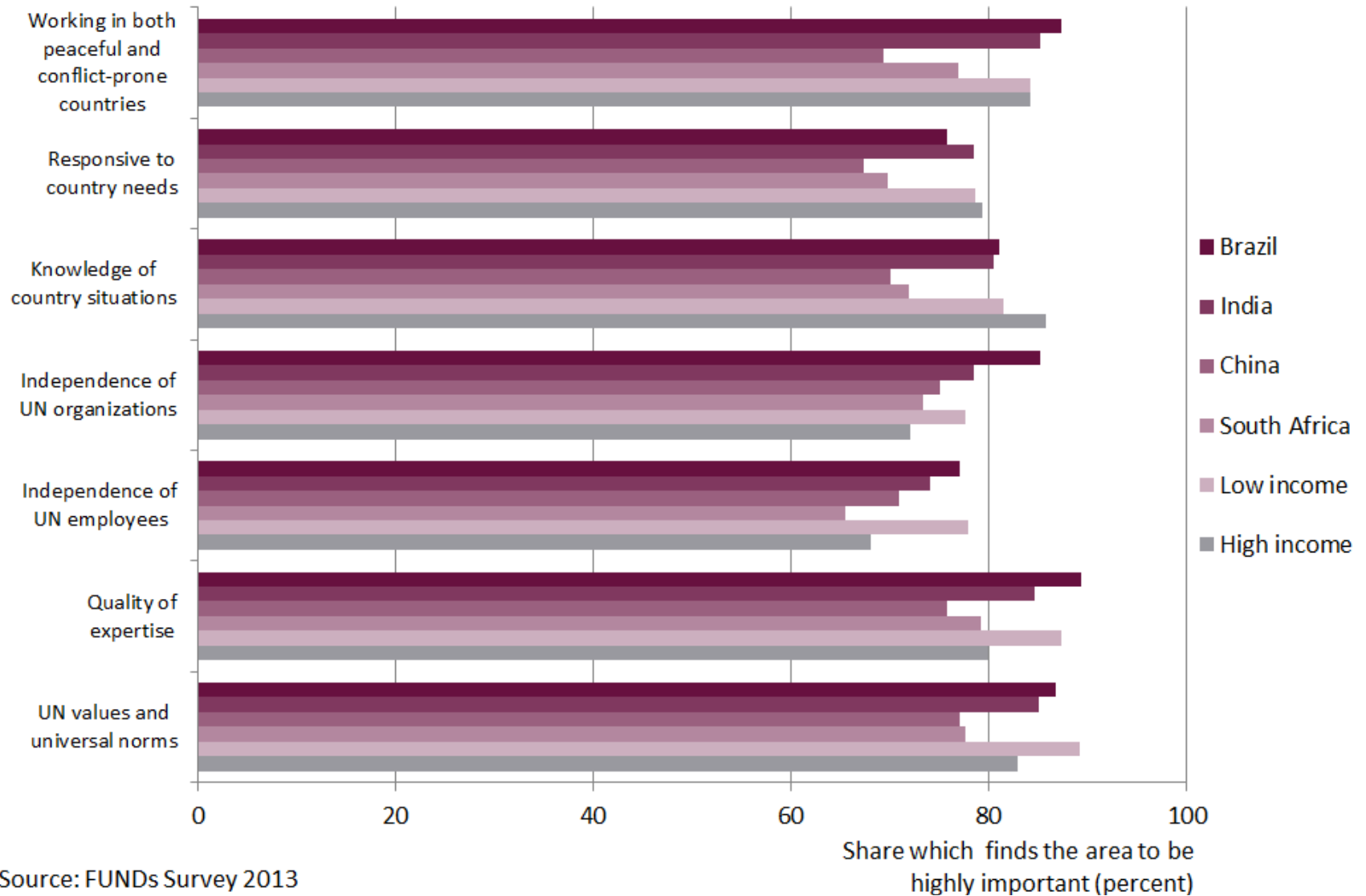

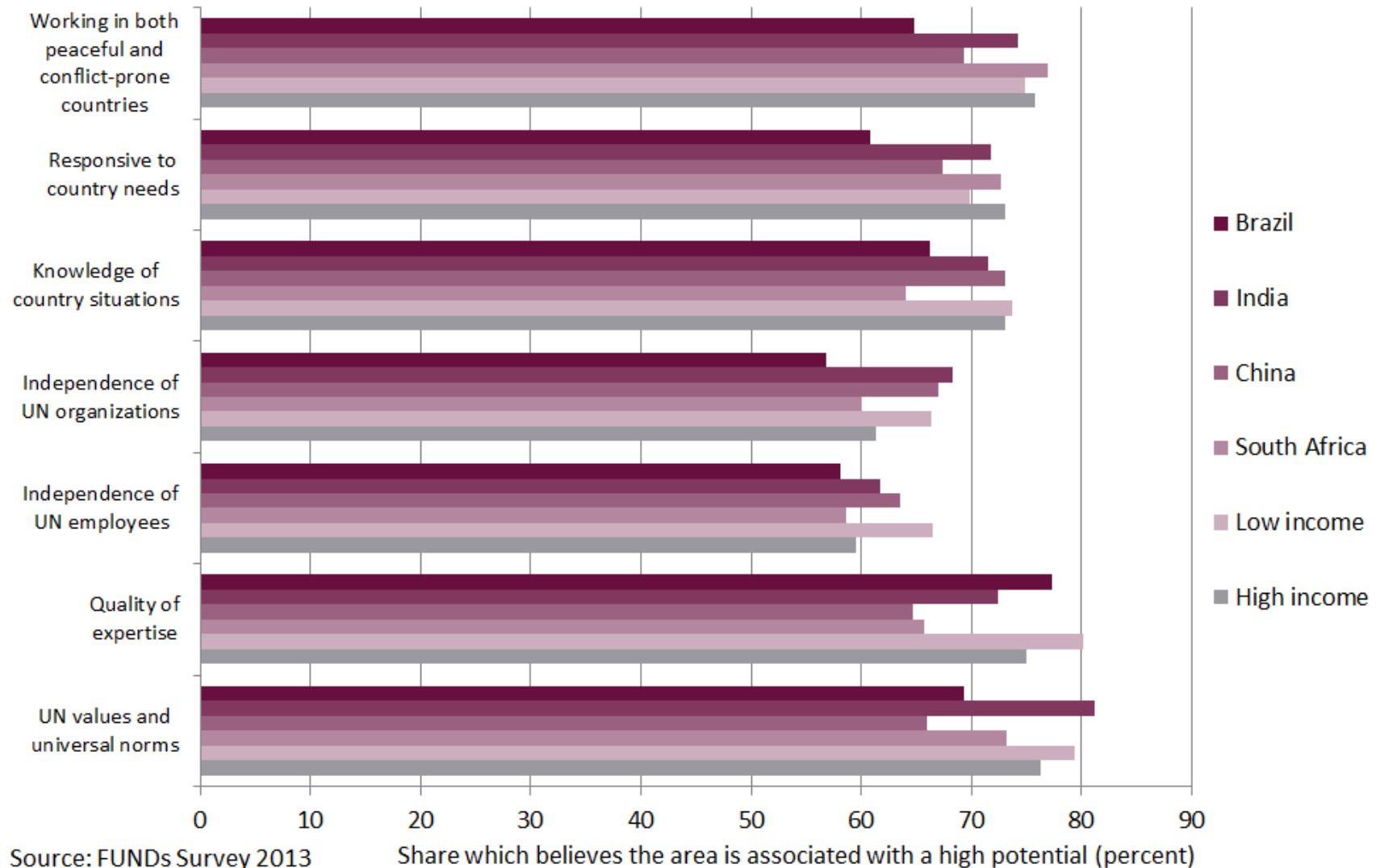

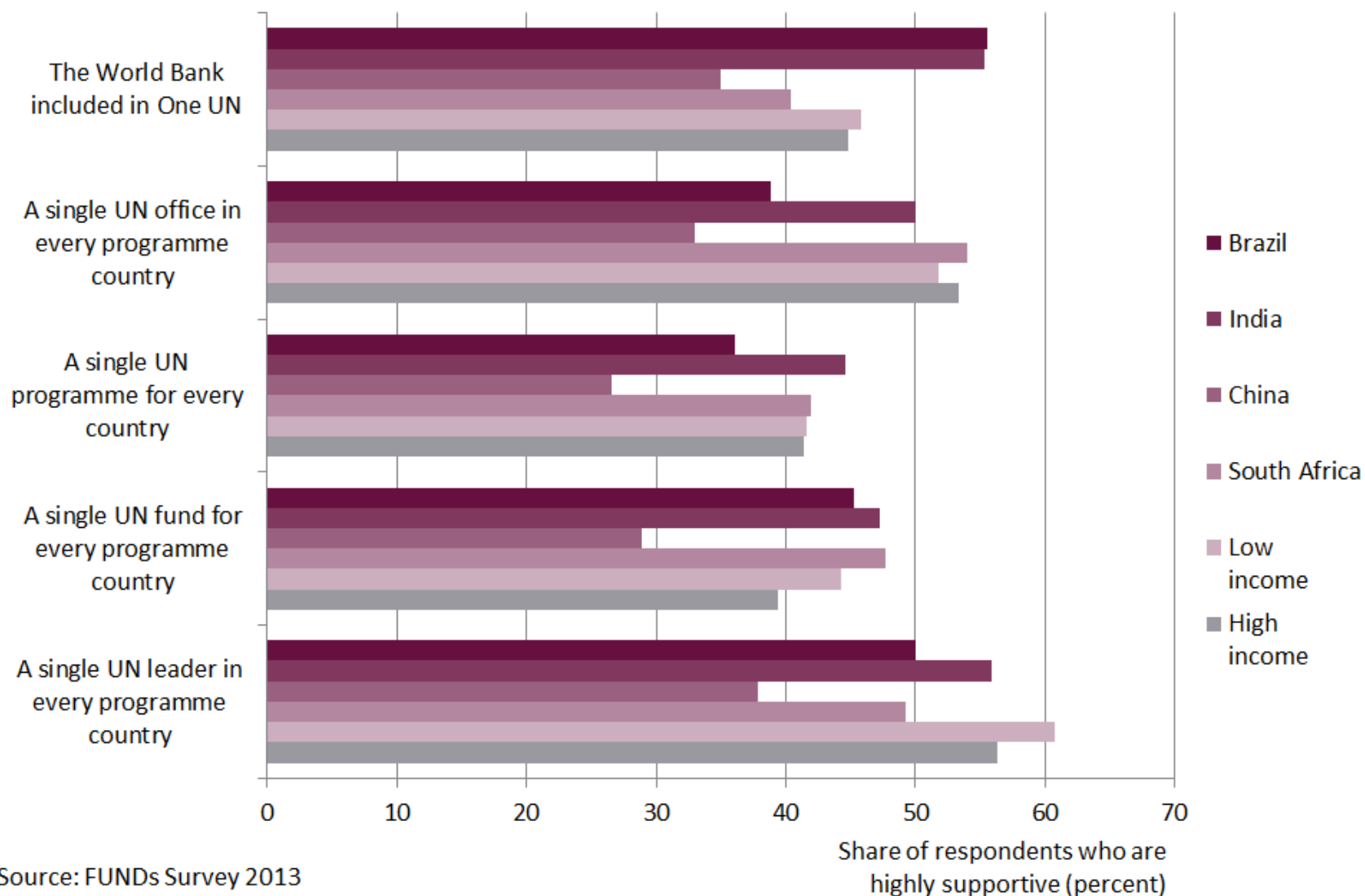

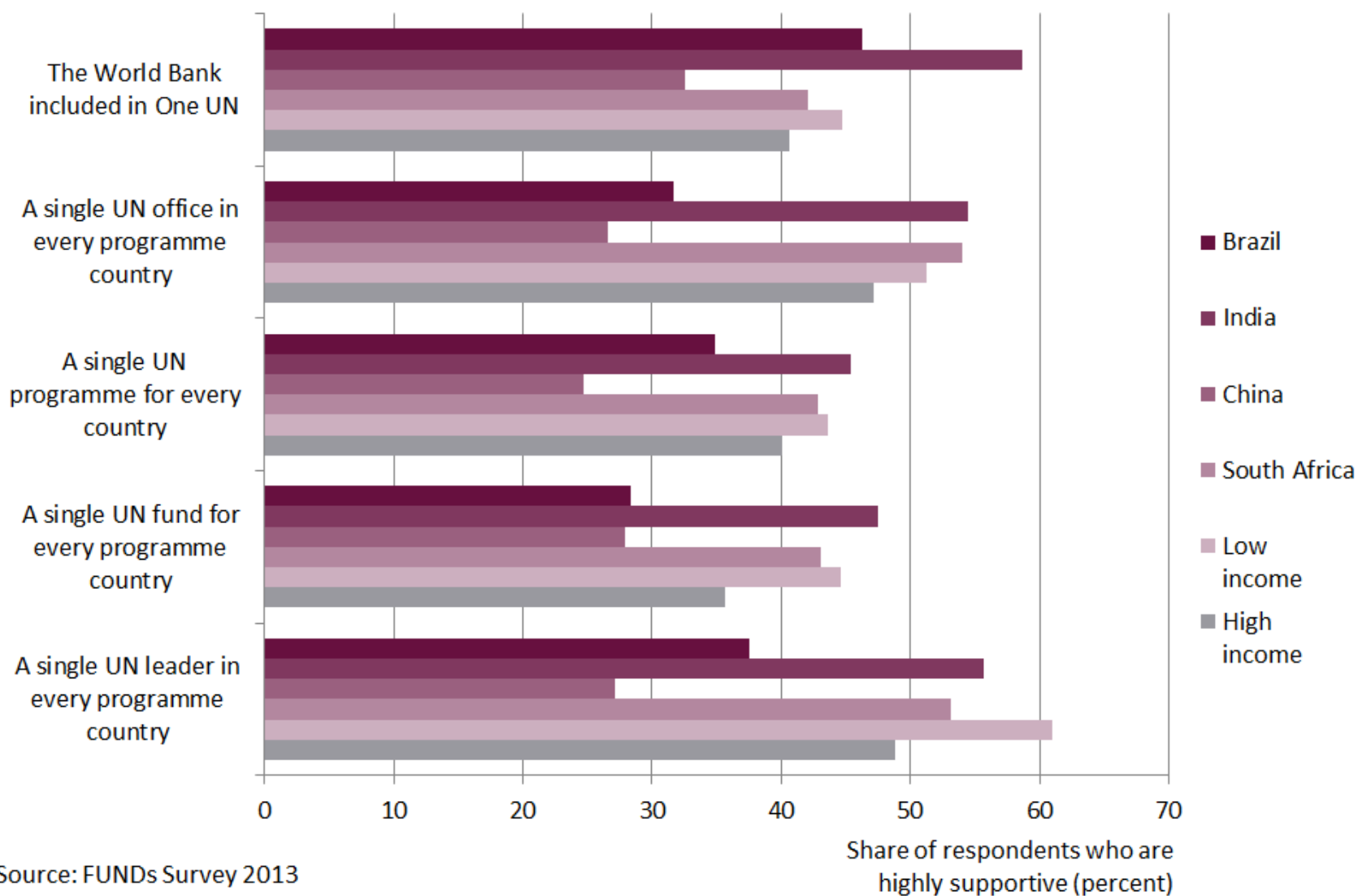

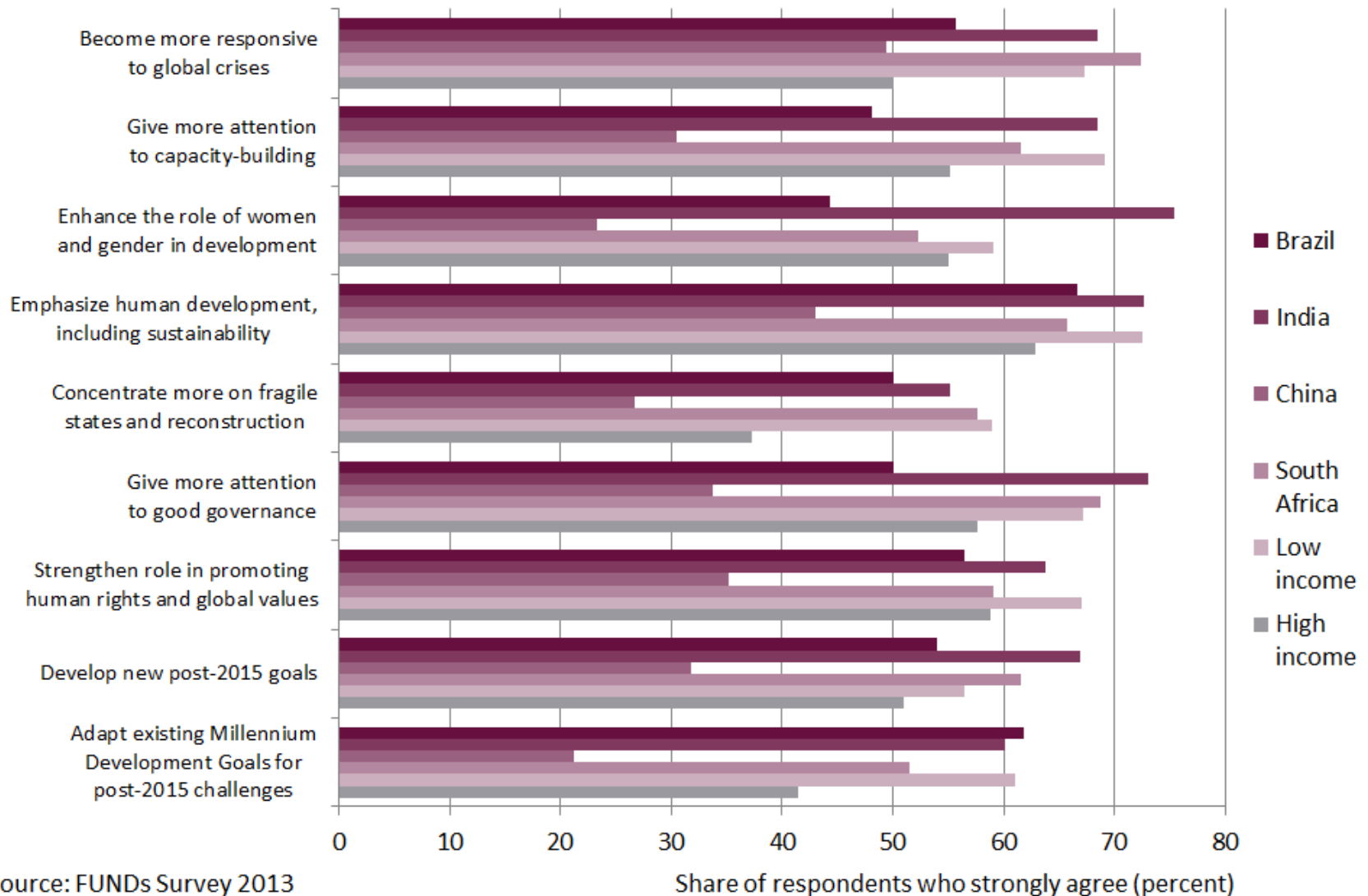

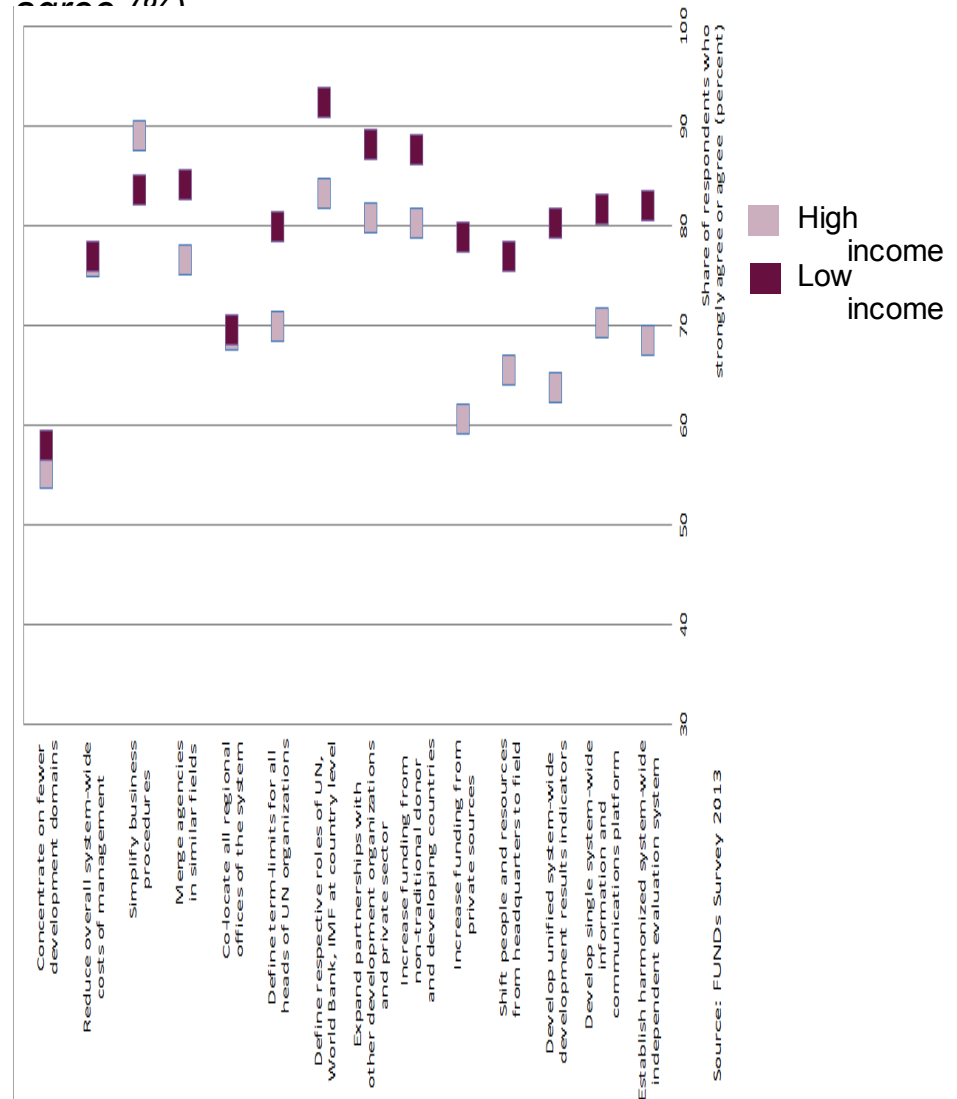

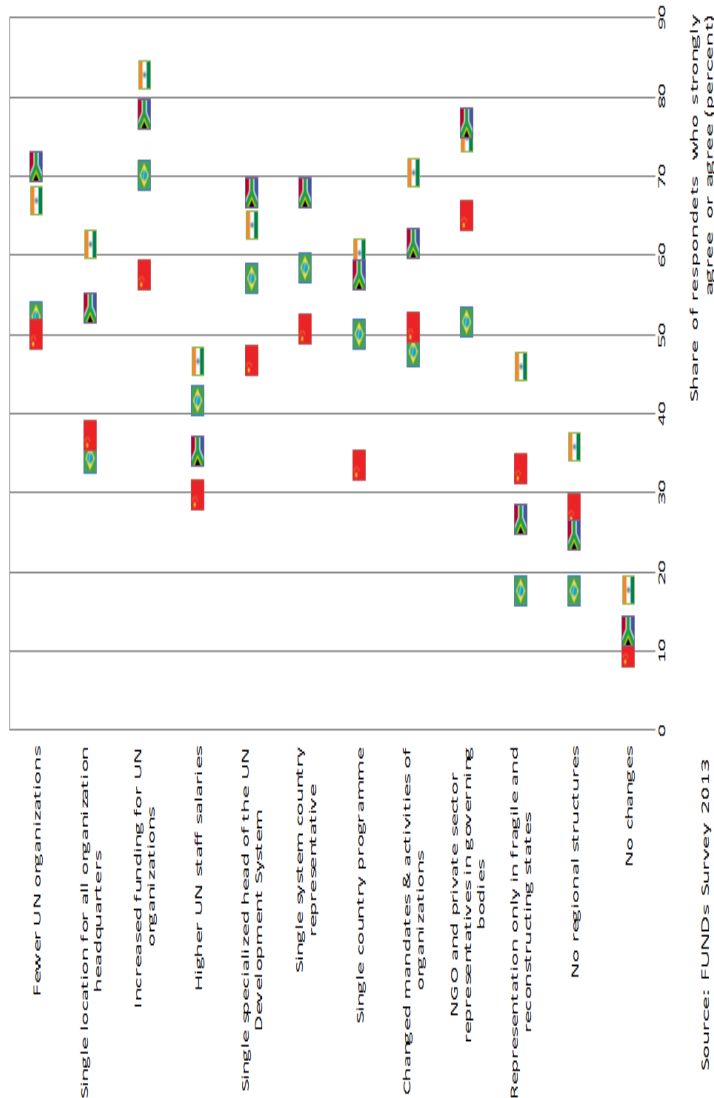
